**AS-NEEDED TRAFFIC ENGINEERING**

The Otay Water District (District) will require the services of a traffic engineering consulting firm(s) to provide professional traffic engineering services in support of the District's Capital Improvement Program (CIP) for a period of three Fiscal Years (FY 2021 - FY 2023) on an as-needed basis, for a not-to-exceed amount of \$175,000. The services may include, but not be limited to, the following: pavement rehabilitation plans, traffic control plans, construction phasing/detour plans, traffic signal plans, traffic signal modification plans, traffic count reports, and other related work in accordance with the regulations and standards of the state and local agencies.

In compliance with SB 854, all Consultants and Sub-Consultants shall be registered with the CA Department of Industrial Relations (DIR). Proposals from consultants not registered with the DIR will be considered unresponsive.
