

ADVERTISEMENT FOR AS-NEEDED CORROSION ENGINEERING SERVICES

The Otay Water District (District) will require the professional services of an engineering consulting firm (Consultant) to provide corrosion engineering services in support of the District's Cathodic Protection Program and Capital Improvement Program (CIP) for a period of one Fiscal Year (FY 2022) on an as-needed basis, for a not-to-exceed amount of \$70,000. The services may include, but not be limited to, design of galvanic and impressed current cathodic protection systems, selection of appropriate corrosion resistant materials such as the use of coatings and linings to prevent corrosion on metallic pipeline and reservoir facilities.

Interested candidates are required to e-mail a Letter of Interest (LOI) and a Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) to Bernardo Separa, Project Manager at bernardos@otaywater.gov. If a firm has submitted a SOQ to the District within the last two (2) calendar years and the qualifications remain current and accurate, then only a Letter of Interest is required.

Consultants must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1 (a)]. If a consultant submits a proposal, but is not registered with the Department of Industrial Relations, their proposal will be considered unresponsive.

Deadline to submit LOI and SOQ will be at 4:00 PM, Thursday, May 27, 2021. Request for Proposal (RFP) materials will be e-mailed to qualified firms on Friday, May 28, 2021. All questions regarding the consulting services should be referred to Bernardo Separa via e-mail prior to issuance of the RFP.
